

ORDINANCE NO. 276

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 226 RELATING TO
REGULATING TRAFFIC AND MISCELLANEOUS OFFENSES IN THE
VILLAGE OF MENDON, ADAMS COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the
Village of Mendon, Adams County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 226 relating to regulating traffic and
miscellaneous offenses in the Village of Mendon is hereby amended as
follows: a new Section of said Ordinance between Section 52 and Section
53 to be designated as "Section 52.1" shall provide as follows:

"Section 52.1. It shall be unlawful for any person to enter upon
or be in the Public Park of the Village of Mendon between the
hours of 11:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. of the following day.
Provided, however, pursuant to written permission requested and
granted by the Board of Trustees, a person or persons may be
granted permission, for good cause shown, to be in the Public
Park of the Village of Mendon during the prohibited hours, and
good cause shall include the protection of public or private
property during special events being held in the public park."

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall go into effect and be enforced
from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
