

AN ORDINANCE CONTROLLING PARKING OF VEHICLES  
IN THE VILLAGE OF MENDON, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Village Board of the Village of Mendon, Illinois,  
as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to permit any vehicle to stop, park or stand on the North side of Collins Street between a point on the North side of Collins Street One Hundred Sixty-five (165) feet West of the intersection of the West line of Fair Street and the North line of Collins Street, and a point on the North line of Collins Street being Two Hundred Ninety-seven (297) feet West of the intersection of the West line of Fair Street and the North line of Collins Street, in the Village of Mendon, Illinois.

Section 2. Any person or entity who violates any of the provisions of this title shall be punishable by a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) provided said fine is paid to the Village of Mendon within five (5) working days of the notice of violation, or if not paid within said five (5) days, then said fine shall be Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00).

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in effect after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be in the same or to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.


