

ORDINANCE NO. 353.07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ANIMALS IN THE VILLAGE OF MENDON, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Mendon, Adams County, Illinois, as follows: That an Ordinance 353.05 entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Animals in the Village of Mendon, Illinois" is hereby amended as follows:

1. SECTION 9 is deleted and there is substituted therefore the following:

SECTION 9. **Limitations of Dogs.**

9.1 **Number of Dogs.** No more than three (3) dogs may be maintained at any household in the Village. "Household" for purposes of this section shall mean one single family dwelling house regardless of the number of people living in the dwelling house. The limitation of three (3) dogs per household shall not apply to new offspring of any dog lawfully maintained in the Village provided the new offspring is removed from the household within six weeks of birth.

9.2 **Female Dog in Heat.** Every female dog shall be confined in a building or secure enclosure in such manner that such female dog in heat cannot come into contact with another animal except for planned breeding.

2. This Ordinance after its passage and approval shall within fourteen (14) days thereof be published once in The Mendon Dispatch-Times, the same being a newspaper published in and having a general circulation in said Village, and this Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after such publication is provided by law.

3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
